The program targets adolescents (age 14 to 17) who have been identified as "at risk" for substance abuse problems. The program is divided into two levels. Level I meets once per week for 1 ½ hours. Level II meets three times per week, three hours per day. The program is also divided into two components: psycho-education and treatment. Length of stay is open-ended.
